- Traffic Safety - Due to ongoing congestion and parking issues around the school, the Traffic Safety Team has started handing out notes reminding drivers not to park, drop/pick up children (unless directed by a volunteer) or stop in the no stopping zones along Adair street. In previous years a blind eye had been turned to parents waiting to pick up children in the no stopping zone after the cones on the south side of Adair. We're now

asking parents to use the 5 minute parking area along the field (which used to be no stopping) instead. We need to keep the no stopping zones clear in order to keep traffic flowing and allow clear sight lines so drivers and children can see each other when children are crossing the street.
